

### Registration for the NGS fall 2018 Juniors and City Soccer Programs is now open.

### **REGISTER NOW**

The <u>Juniors Program</u> is for girls in grades K-2. The <u>City Program</u> is for girls in grades 3-9. Both programs offer a recreation-focused soccer experience that emphasizes fun, health and exercise. Players of all skill levels are welcome to register. Our programs are open to girls who live in or attend school in Newton.

### Fall 2018 Season Schedule

The 10-week season starts on Saturday, September 8 and ends November 10, 2018. Games will be played over Columbus Day weekend and Veteran's Day weekend.

We cannot finalize our Saturday game schedules, practice schedules (for J2 & City), or field assignments until the City of Newton issues field permits. This often doesn't happen until August. However, the current season's game schedules are posted and they tend not to deviate much from year to year. Coaches make every effort to find a practice time that works for most of their players.

### **Teams**

Girls in our kindergarten program are not placed on teams and do not need to make friend requests. Our professional coaches will lead the entire group in learning activities for the first half of the session and will divide the players into smaller groups for the second half of the session.

Juniors Grade 1, Juniors Grade 2, and City players are placed on grade-level teams. Please note that we are a community program, not a school-based program. Therefore, we purposely

create teams with girls from multiple neighboring schools and honor only one mutual friend request per player. Teams are generally mixed up from year-to-year so that players have the opportunity to

- develop good sportsmanship skills, winning some games and losing some games
- develop social skills, playing with friends and making new friends
- develop soccer skills, learning from multiple coaches

Families will be notified of their fall team placements by email in late summer. Please help your daughter have a positive soccer experience by supporting her assigned team.

### **Registration Deadlines**

You must register by August 1 to be guaranteed a spot on a Juniors or City team and to make a friend request. Setting up teams is a complicated process and late registrations delay team announcements and scheduling. Please support our efforts by meeting this registration deadline.

After August 1, we will continue to accept registrations but your daughter may be placed on a wait list. If your daughter is put on a wait list, we will make every effort to place her on a team but it may not be a team with other players from her school. You are only charged if your daughter is placed on a team.

### **Registration Fee**

The registration fee is \$180 for the fall season. If you register before August 1, you will receive a \$50 early registration discount.

### **Sibling Discount**

NGS provides a \$20 discount per-child for siblings in the juniors, city and travel programs. Our online registration system will only automatically apply the sibling discount if you register two or more children in the same NGS program at the same time. If your children play in different NGS programs, email <a href="mailto:registrar@newtongirlssoccer.org">registrar@newtongirlssoccer.org</a> BEFORE you register to get a \$20 discount code. We cannot apply the discount after you have already registered and paid.

### **Scholarships**

It is the policy of Newton Girls Soccer that no girl should be denied the opportunity to play soccer due to her family's financial situation. To request financial assistance, email the NGS President at <a href="mailto:president@newtongirlssoccer.org">president@newtongirlssoccer.org</a>. All scholarship requests are confidential. NGS may request documentation of need.

Requests should be submitted by email at least 7 days before the program registration deadline. Scholarships cannot be applied retroactively. Once you have registered and paid, we cannot refund your money in lieu of a scholarship.

Your request should include:

- Player's Name and Grade
- · Guardians' Name, Phone Number, and Email
- Program Name
- Amount that you are able to contribute towards the registration fee

## **Cancellation/Refund Policy**

Registrants must cancel prior to **August 1** to receive a refund, less a **\$25** cancellation fee. After this date, there are no refunds, except in the following situations:

- If a player moves out of Newton and notifies the registrar before the season starts, she may receive a refund of the registration fee, less a cancellation fee. Proof of relocation must be submitted when requesting the refund. Once the season starts, there are no refunds for moves.
- If a player has a season-ending injury, she may receive a pro-rated refund. A note from a doctor must be submitted within two weeks of the injury.

### Uniforms

The uniform for all girls playing in the Juniors and City Programs is a reversible (orange on one side, white on the other), numbered NGS jersey with the player's last name printed on the orange side. Players may wear any color soccer shorts, socks, and shin guards; these items can be purchased on your own from any retailer.

Your order will be shipped directly to you from our vendor and generally within 10-12 days. However, we recommend that you place your order at least three weeks before the season begins – by August 18 – to ensure that your player has a jersey for the first game.

Because these are custom orders, no returns or refunds are accepted. We suggest that you confirm the size before placing an order. Sample sizes are available to try on at Lapels Dry Cleaners located at 319 Walnut Street in Newtonville (617-527-6700).

You only need to order a jersey if your daughter doesn't have one or if her current jersey no longer fits.

### **Volunteering/Coaching**

NGS relies on parent coaches to help us accommodate the 1200+ girls who participate in our programs each year. All volunteers receive support and guidance. Our main prerequisite for volunteers is a willingness to learn and a commitment to show up. By all accounts, it is very rewarding to work with our soccer players and with the other volunteers in our community! Coaching a team includes teaching game skills, sportsmanship, team play, and other aspects of the game, as well as providing a high level of organization to the team both on and off the field. You will receive coach education and materials.

If you would like to coach, please sign up on Blue Sombrero when you register your daughter for the season. We cannot form teams until we identify a head coach for each team. No experience is necessary, especially in the younger grades. Volunteers will be contacted by a grade coordinator when we know what our coaching needs are.

### **Player Safety Policy**

Please DO NOT pierce ears within 6 weeks of the season start date. Players may not wear jewelry during practices or games. This includes, but is not limited to bracelets, necklaces, earrings, rings, beads, barrettes and other hard or sharp items. Newly pierced ears may not be

taped. Earrings must be removed. Players may not participate with casts or splints of any kind. If a player refuses or is unable to remove the prohibited item, she will be asked to sit on the sidelines and may not participate in the soccer activity. There are no exceptions to this rule for the safety of all our players.

# 9<sup>th</sup> graders

If you are considering registering your 9<sup>th</sup> grader for the NGS City 7/8/9 program this fall, the coaches at Newton South and Newton North have requested that you first contact your high school to learn about the Freshman Soccer Program. They have a no-cut policy for freshman, so it is a great opportunity to be involved in your school's athletics. NGS will also offer 9th grade soccer in the spring when Freshman Soccer is not in session.
